### *Research, Larger Systems, Training Posters*

#### **Sponsored by the AFTA Research Committee**

Our AFTA colleagues are doing creative and effective work in many areas of the field. The Poster Festival will provide an opportunity for presenters to share a variety of different types of work and conduct a lively exchange with others. Faculty at graduate programs are encouraged to enlist graduate students in creating a poster and in inviting those students to attend the meeting with them.

Posters may feature one or more of the following:

- (1) research involving families
- (2) intervention with families in larger systems or out of the “therapy office”
- (3) family therapy training programs or initiatives
- (4) health care policy
- (5) social justice issues

Each poster will be set up by the presenter in a visual display on one or two free standing tri-fold poster boards (each approximately 3 feet high and 4 feet wide).

Attendees may visit all of the posters and have individual conversation with the authors. Presenters should also bring with them copies of a two-page summary of their work to hand out to people who visit their display. We hope to be able to accommodate anyone who wishes to present.
